

**VALLEY HIGH SCHOOL/VALLEY SOUTHWOODS
FALL ORCHESTRA SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

Eligibility requirements and rules are:

- A. Applicants will be judged on **merit** (based on your past and current orchestra participation level), your character reference letter and your letter indicating your use for the scholarship.
- B. Only freshmen or higher will be considered.
- C. A person can receive only one scholarship per scholarship year (August 1 through July 31 annually), but the Valley Orchestra Guild may, at its discretion, continue to support prior scholarship winners in successive years. Students must reapply each year.
- D. Two scholarships will be offered during the school year. One scholarship will be awarded in the fall and the other scholarship will be awarded in the spring. Eligible students should apply as soon as possible.
- E. Maximum scholarship award will be \$250.00.
- F. Applicant must be enrolled at Valley Southwoods, Walnut Creek Campus or Valley High School.

NOTE: Valley Orchestra Guild does not discriminate against any minority or any protected group including those based on race, religion, sex, national origin, or disability. Financial need has been eliminated as an eligibility requirement. There are no exceptions to these written rules. The fall scholarship will be judged in a non-discriminatory manner using the criteria printed above. Only those limitations or restrictions printed above will be used. All Federal IRS rules and State of Iowa non-profit group tax requirement rulings will be followed. Neither oral statement nor any variation from this established set of rules would supersede this form. Students who meet these eligibility requirements are encouraged to apply annually.
